# **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India,  
Gandhinagar, Gujarat.**

National Forensic Sciences University (NFSU) and the Jammu and Kashmir Forensic Science Laboratory (JKFSL) have many areas of common interest and considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education, trainings and research.

**Objective: -** The general objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to stimulate and facilitate the advancement of collaborative and mutually beneficial academic activities which serve to enhance the institutional development for both the parties.

**Background:-** JKFSL is providing quality, on time and credible forensic science services, to law enforcement agencies in Jammu and Kashmir and other institutions, in crime detection case examination and adequate scientific support to criminal justice delivery system.

The JKFSL represented by its Director, herein after referred to as FSL which expression shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns; as the **First Party**.

**Whereas,** the National Forensic Sciences University, an Institution of National Importance, is established by an Act passed by the Parliament of India in the year 2020, to facilitate and promote higher education, research and training to strengthen the forensic capabilities and achieve excellence in the field of forensic science in conjunction with applied behavioural science studies, law, criminology, technology and other allied areas, and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. The status of "Centre of Excellence" and "Institute of Strategic or Security related Interest" is also granted to the University by the Government of Gujarat and the status of "Centre of Excellence for Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances" is conferred by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India.

The National forensic Sciences University represented by the Campus Director, hence referred to as NFSU, which expression shall

mean and include its successor and permitted assigns, as the **Second Party**.

**And, whereas,** all the parties acknowledge each other's respective roles in strengthening the justice delivery system through forensic and allied sciences.

**And, whereas,** the above parties recognize that the academic, research and training collaboration would be of mutual benefit and would provide strengths in research and education and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic and research cooperation it is mutually agreed that:

1. The purpose of the cooperation between NFSU and FSL under this MoU are as follows:
  - a. To stimulate and facilitate the advancement of collaborative and mutually beneficial academic activities which serve to enhance the institutional development for both the parties.
  - b. To engage with each other in a pursuit to transform FSL into 'centre of excellence' in all fields of Forensic Science.
2. Both the parties agree to promote interest in the teaching, research and training activities in the field of forensic science in general as under;
  - i. Exchange of faculty and Scientists to the mutual benefit of both institutions;
  - ii. organize symposia, conferences, workshops, short term courses and meetings on research issues and forensic problems;
  - iii. carry out joint research and continuing education programs;
  - iv. exchange information pertaining to developments in teaching, student development and research at each institution;

- v. Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest;
- vi. Exchange of academic materials and publications;
- vii. Terms and conditions for any joint work, assignment or such exchange, including those concerning financial implications will be worked out between mutually by the concerned parties.

- 3. This agreement shall remain in effect for a period of 03 years.
- 4. In case of any dispute, arising between and the parties, it shall be resolved amicably.


